## The David Raitt Trophy Tournament

- 1. The format is 18 holes, individual stableford scoring. Teams of eight players with the best seven scores to count.
- 2. Full handicap allowance, (capped at 28) Yellow tees.
- 3. Each team will comprise of eight players all of whom must be age 60 or over on the date of competition.
- 3. The seven best stableford scores will count towards the team total.
- 4. The winning team will receive the David Raitt Trophy and each team member will also receive a prize. There are also prizes for the second and third placed team members. All prizes are provided by the event sponsor; David Raitt.
- 5. In the event of a tie, the eighth players score will be entered, in the event of a further tie, a countback over the last nine holes played by the eighth player. If there is still a tie, it will be decided by the last six hole, then the last three then the last one taken from the eighth players card.
- 6. The competition is a shotgun start at 09.00hrs, all players will be designated a start hole prior to the event and players are asked to assemble on the driving range tees by **08.45** where a WGC member will be waiting with the respective hole no displayed, to escort you to your allocated start tee.
- 7. Handicap certificates will be required to be produced by all winning team members.
